## **General Information**

**Housing Policy:** We encourage families to bring their own housing (a trailer or tent). However, if you are in need of a cabin and fall into one of the following categories, you must register by June 1. Cabins are reserved for elderly, those with special needs, large families of 6+ and families with small children. If you do not have a tent or trailer, we have a few family tents available for use, but they are on a first come first served basis. Be sure and register and let us know your needs. Thank you for your help in this regard. We want to accommodate as many families as possible.

**What to Bring:** Sleeping bags, bedding, flashlights, warm clothing for evenings and mornings, Bible, notebook, a mattress or pad (some are available on a first come basis), daily necessities, etc.

**What not to Bring:** Any form of tobacco, illegal drugs, or alcoholic beverages. No fireworks. We discourage pets; however a few are allowed on a limited basis as long as they are kept on a leash.

**Directions to Camp:**

To get to Camp Utibaca, take Hwy 89 to Ephraim. Turn East at 400 South Street. Go to 300 East Street and turn right. Follow this road around the curve and up Ephraim Canyon. When the road turns from pavement to gravel go about 3.8 miles further and angle right on the Willow Creek Road (Rd. 50051 and it is on a curve). After you cross the first cattle guard go about two miles further. Then angle off to the right just before the next cattle guard. Follow this road across the field and down the hill into Camp Utibaca.

**Registration:** It would help us in preparing for the week to have all families register. We will always accept walk-ins. If you cannot register ahead of time, but can come anyway, please come. Below is the registration form. Please indicate your housing need and reason if needing a cabin. (See housing policy above).
